#### **Goodfellows Facts**

- There are 34 Old Newsboys Newspaper Teams with an average of 600 volunteers.
- Goodfellows Food Bank is open two days a week, year-round.
- They provide 13,000 boxes of food.
- Food costs approximately \$1.3 million and is purchased locally.
- They feed approximately 40,000 people.
- Grocery store certificates (included in the Christmas boxes) cost \$100,000.
- · Lunch bags for homeless cost \$100,000.
- 29 schools share \$116,000 for the Breakfast/Nutrition program.
- Footwear program costs \$90,000 for new shoes / boots for children in JK to grade 8.
- 120,000 copies of the Goodfellows Newspaper are donated by the Windsor Star.
- There are 34 Old Newsboys Newspaper Teams with an average of 600 volunteers.
- · This accounts for 40% of funds raised.
- Mailed out Appeal Brochures fundraiser accounts for 45% of their income.
- They have only one paid staff member with administrative cost of only 5%.
- Goodfellows have been part of our community for over 110 years.
